

Summary of Our Financial Model

I've been a "believer" for over 40 years, and I have heard countless friends and "others" say how they want to be "In the Ministry." Many also wanted to draw a salary from that ministry. So, they "raised support" to accomplish that.

I believe that "support" for a salary "should be" provided for those who go overseas as missionaries and in "select" situations here in the States. I am NOT a fan of supporting everyone with a salary who wants to be in the ministry. Most should work at a job or business or have personal finances to do the ministry God has called them to.

Therefore, since beginning the Good Mood Foundation in 2005, I have not received any salary, royalty, or financial benefit from our ministry. Instead, I have and continue to give thousands of dollars each year to our ministry.

But we can't do "our" ministry without the financial support of those impacted personally and want to pay it forward to benefit others.

That said, I would also like to point out the following.

1. I do not collect home addresses, email addresses, or phone numbers at our "Feasts of Israel" presentations or other ministry activities. Nor do I ask anyone who attends to pay for the resources and items we provide.
2. At the "heart" of our financial model is that God can direct anyone to do whatever He wants. I trust HIM as my "source" — not anyone else.
3. Funds provided pay for the "items" we use during ministry — not overhead., i.e., rent, salary, etc. Those who participate financially will receive a few "update" letters or emails and a "Year-End" letter.

I am also happy to answer any questions about our finances and continue to believe that anyone who prays, volunteers, or gives is a part of this ministry.
