To end the Feast of Passover, **the father pours out the fourth "cup" of wine**, which is significantly different in appearance and meaning from the previous three cups. This cup is for a "special person," Elijah, and is called "**Elijah's Cup**." Traditionally, Elijah's "place setting" is set at the Passover table, and the back door of the Jewish home is left slightly open, just in case Elijah comes in to partake of Passover.



The Romans destroyed Jerusalem and the Second Temple in 70 AD, and the Jewish people were scattered to the "four corners" of the world. Therefore, for the past 2,000 years, to conclude the "Passover," the father poured "Elijah's Cup" and prayed, "**Next Year in Jerusalem.**" The final prayer of Passover was asking God to restore the Jews to their Land, "Israel," so they could celebrate Passover "again" in Jerusalem. The Jewish people knew their Bible and that their God had made a covenant with them regarding their Land. They had HOPE—it was just a matter of time. In 1877, Naftali Imber, a Jewish poet, wrote "Hatikva," which became Israel's National Anthem. The lyrics reflect the Jewish people's hope to return to Jerusalem so they could celebrate Passover there.

As a "direct" result of the Holocaust, the HEART of the "Nations" was open and receptive to providing the Jewish People with "Land" to become a State again. Therefore, on **May 14, 1948**, the State of Israel was reborn. The "Land" they were given is the same Land that God had promised to His people, the Jews, and the same Land they had "Occupied" thousands of years earlier. Interestingly, the prophet Isaiah prophesied this miraculous event. "**Before she goes into labor, she gives birth; before the pains come upon her, she delivers a son. Who has ever heard of such a thing? Who has ever seen such things? Can a country be born in a day or a nation be brought forth in a moment?**" Isaiah 66:7–13.



The Jewish people began returning to Israel, but Jerusalem was still not under Israeli control, so the father continued to pray "**Next Year in Jerusalem**" to end the Passover. Then, yet again, by God's miracle-working power, on **June 7, 1967**, as a result of the "Six-Day" War, God enabled the Jews to recapture Jerusalem. As Israeli paratroopers entered through the "Lion's Gate" and captured the "Western Wall." Rabbi Shlomo Goren, the IDF chief rabbi, blew the **Shofar Trumpet** for the "first" time at the "Western Wall" and quoted. "**When you go into battle in your own Land against an enemy who is oppressing you, sound a blast on the trumpets. Then you will be remembered by the LORD your God and rescued from your enemies**" Numbers 10:9. At this **MOMENT**, the prayers of the Jews were answered, and another of Isaiah's prophecies was fulfilled. "**They will enter Zion with singing; everlasting joy will crown their heads. Gladness and joy will overtake them, and sorrow and sighing will flee away**" Isaiah 35:1–10. Therefore, "**Sound the Trumpets in Zion,**" — Jerusalem, "Zion" — the City of God, has been "redeemed" and is **NOW** under Jewish control. The father's prayer to end Passover, "**Next Year in Jerusalem,**" has been answered.

My Motivation Behind Writing This Book

After visiting Israel for an "Introductory Tour" of the Biblical sites in 2013, I returned and began writing "**Next Year in Jerusalem is Now.**" I know that by visiting Israel and the Biblical sites, your Bible will "come to life" as you experience the "places" where Jesus, our Messiah, ministered and the Biblical events that took place there.

The road map for the manuscript begins in the first section. God promised Abraham and his descendants a Land— what we know as the "Land of Israel." So, I provide a modest Biblical understanding of Israel's background.

God gave His People "The Law" through Moses via the Mosaic Covenant. Israel's long history and many of its culture, traditions, etc., are based on this Fifth Covenant. One of the primary "instructions" God initiated was the sacrificial system, which began in the Tabernacle and continued into the First and Second Temples. Because the "First Man," Adam, sinned, all people are born tainted with sin. The blood sacrifices of animals (that His People sacrificed) provided a "Temporary Solution" to the issue of how to deal with sin. God's Word declares that without the shedding of blood, there is no remission or forgiveness of sin. So, in the second section, I cover the groundwork of understanding this and God's other Covenants. However, the sacrificial system was a "Temporary Solution," so God, through His prophet Jeremiah, said He was going to provide a "New Covenant" to replace the Mosaic or "Old Covenant."

The "New Covenant" was initiated when Jesus Christ, God's Son, put ALL sin on Himself and died on the cross. Therefore, the third section contains many Scriptures and stories about HIM and a Biblical presentation of the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

With the roadmap and three sections of "Israel," "Covenants," and "Gospel" in place, I inserted the Biblical sites seen on an "Introductory Troup" of Israel into the section that best illustrates the main points of that section. The organization of these sites helps tell the story of Israel, His People, and God's plan to provide "Salvation" for ISRAEL. The book concludes with a tour of the "**Via Delarosa**" and my father's heartwarming testimony.
