### *The Meaning Behind the Title and Subtitle*

To understand the meaning behind the title of my book *“Sound the Trumpets in Zion,”* and subtitled, *“Next Year in Jerusalem is Now,”* let’s go back to the “Passover Feast,” which has been celebrated by the Jewish People for over 3,500 years. During the Passover, the father pours four cups of wine, and each has a significant meaning. The third cup of wine is called the “Cup of Redemption” and is the “cup” Jesus took **“After Supper”** when He introduced His disciples to what we now call “Communion.” The “4th Cup” of wine is called “Elijah’s Cup” and is distinctly different than the other three cups. Elijah is the most celebrated person to the Jewish People other than the “Messiah.” So, after the father pours “Elijah’s Cup, he prayed, *“Next Year in Jerusalem.”*”



Throughout Israel’s history, there were times when the Jewish People controlled Jerusalem and could celebrate Passover there. However, in 70 AD, the Romans destroyed the Jewish Temple and the City of Jerusalem. The Jewish People were exiled to the four corners of the World. So for the past 2,000 years, the Passover ended with the fathers’ prayer, *“Next Year in Jerusalem,”* expressing the Jewish people’s desire to return to Jerusalem to celebrate Passover there again. Then in 1945, after the end of World War 2, the World’s attention focused on the Jewish People and what they endured during the Holocaust. A series of historical events occurred, culminating with the State of Israel being ‘re-born on **May 14, 1948.** God’s “Promised Land,” which they had occupied for thousands of years earlier, was given back to them, and the Jewish people began returning to **“ZION”** (which can refer to God’s People, the Jews, the Land of Israel, and Jerusalem.) However, “Zion,” Jerusalem, was still not under their control, so the Jews continued to end the Passover with the prayer, *“Next Year in Jerusalem.”*”

Then again, by God’s miracle-working power, on **June 7, 1967,** after the “Six-Day War,” God enabled the Jews to recapture “Zion”- Jerusalem. Pictured are some of the paratroopers after they entered through “The Lion’s Gate” and captured the “Western Wall.” In the center of the photo is Rabbi Shlomo Goren, chief rabbi of the IDF, blowing a Shofar (God’s Trumpet). After the “Western Wall” was captured, it is said that Rabbi Goren was the “first” person to blow the Shofar at the “Western Wall.” And as Rabbi Goren blew the **Shofar Trumpet,** he quoted the following verse.



- “When you go into battle in your own land against an enemy who is oppressing you, sound a blast on the trumpets. Then you will be remembered by the LORD your God and rescued from your enemies.” Numbers 10:9

After the Israelis “recaptured” “Zion”- Jerusalem and took over control of the “Western Wall,” tens of thousands of Jews who were living in Israel ran to “Zion”- Jerusalem, crying in tears. They shouted, “The Wall is Ours” and “The City is Ours,” and they “wept” for many days. That is why the **Western Wall** is also referred to as the **Wailing Wall.** “Zion”- Jerusalem is now once again under Israel’s control and is now the Capital of Israel. Jews now live in “Zion” and come to “Zion” to celebrate the Passover there. *Therefore,*

### God’s Trumpets

**The Following Stories will form the basis for a “Screenplay” and “The Venue” - Museum.**

### Trumpets Sounded in the Past

Mount Moriah – The story of Abraham and Isaac and the “Shofar Trumpet” (Ram’s Horn) is unveiled. Anyone can sound the Shofar.

Mount Sinai – Israel receives instructions for obeying the “Law or the “Old Covenant.” Before Moses goes up to receive the Law and when Moses comes down with the Law, God’s Angel’s sound Trumpets, and God’s People are afraid. Israel also receives instructions for building the Tabernacle and the institution of the “Sacrificial System.” Temple Trumpets are introduced, which only the “Priests could sound. Israel also receives instructions for celebrating, “Seven Feasts.”

Mount Zion – The sounding of Trumpets “connects” many of the people, places, and events in Israel’s history.

- ❖ With Trumpets and shouts-the walls of Jericho came down.
- ❖ Ehud defeats the Moabites and sounds the Trumpet.
- ❖ Sound the Trumpet-it’s time to praise the Lord.
- ❖ Israel’s Kings and the sounding of Trumpets.
- ❖ King Saul sounds the Trumpet presumptuously.
- ❖ Trumpets are sounded as David returns God’s “Ark” to Jerusalem.
- ❖ Solomon is anointed King of Israel with Trumpets sounding.
- ❖ With Trumpets, King Solomon announces, God’s Temple will be built.
- ❖ King Solomon’s Temple is dedicated with many Trumpets sounding.
- ❖ King Abijah’s “Priests” sound Trumpets, and King Jeroboam is defeated.
- ❖ With Trumpets, God’s Judgments are pronounced on Moab.
- ❖ Sound Trumpets- King Jehoshaphat celebrates God’s victory.
- ❖ Joash is anointed King of Judah with Trumpets.
- ❖ Return to The Lord- faithless Israel, sound Trumpets, and return to Zion.
- ❖ Gideon defeats the Midianites as “300” Trumpets are sounded.
- ❖ King Hezekiah purifies the Temple as Trumpets are sounded.
- ❖ With Trumpets, Jehu is anointed King of Israel.
- ❖ “Watchmen”-sound the Trumpet.
- ❖ With Trumpets-the rebuilding of the First Temple begins.
- ❖ The Foundation of the Temple is now complete-sound Trumpets.
- ❖ The Rebuilt Temple is completed-sound Trumpets.
- ❖ Nehemiah begins rebuilding the “Walls of Jerusalem”-sound the Trumpets.
- ❖ With Trumpets, the “Walls of Jerusalem” are now rebuilt and rededicated.

### **John Hears a Loud Voice LIKE a Trumpet. It’s Jesus-**

*“I, John...was on the island of Patmos... On the Lord’s Day, I was in the Spirit, and I heard behind me a loud voice like a trumpet, “Write on a scroll what you see and send it to the seven churches... “Write, therefore, what you have seen, what is now, and what will take place later.”*

**After writing “Seven Letters,” John is “up” ushered into God’s Throne Room, and he records the “events” Jesus shows him must take place in the future.**

*“After this, I looked, and there before me was a door standing open in heaven. And the voice I had first heard speaking to me like a trumpet said, “Come up here, and I will show you what must take place after this.”*

### **The 9<sup>th</sup> of Av –**

Many “calamities” have befallen on the Jewish People, and many of them occurred on the same day, the 9<sup>th</sup> of Av. But the God of the Bible was working “behind the scenes” to orchestrate Israel’s redemption. The most horrific calamity was the Holocaust, but as a direct result of it, on May 14, 1948, Israel was “Re-born. The “Land of Israel” was “returned” to the Jewish People, and Jews from around the World began returning “Home.” However, Jerusalem was not under Israeli control, so the Jews continued to end the Feast of “Passover” with this prayer, “*Next Year in Jerusalem.*” This prayer expressed the Jewish People’s “Hope” that “One Day,” Jews could once again celebrate Passover in Jerusalem. On June 7, 1967, Israel won the “6 Day War” and recaptured Jerusalem. And as Israel’s Defense Forces entered the area of the “Western Wall,” in Jerusalem, Rabbi Shlomo Goren blew a “Shofar Trumpet” and quoted this verse,

*“When you go into battle in your own land against an enemy who is oppressing you, sound a blast on the trumpets. Then you will be remembered by the LORD your God and rescued from your enemies.”*

### **Sound the Trumpets in Zion –**

The 2,000- year old prayer that ended Passover, “*Next Year in Jerusalem,*” is now a reality. Passover can now be celebrated in Jerusalem. “*Next Year in Jerusalem-is Now!*”

### **This is the “Day of the Lord.” It is here, and it is Coming**

*“For the day of the LORD is near...Blow the trumpet in Zion; sound the alarm on my holy hill...for the day of the LORD is coming. It is close at hand.”*

## **Trumpets Will Sound in the Future**

### **Heavenly Mount-**

God will give Seven Angels a “Temple Trumpet” to sound. The first four “Trumpets” are “sounded,” and Tribulation is unleashed on the earth. Trumpets five, six, and seven are called “Woe Trumpets.” God also instructs other Angels to gather His “elect.”

*“He will send his angels with a loud trumpet call, and they will gather his elect from the four winds, from one end of the heavens to the other.”*

### **Jesus Will Return After the Seventh Angel Sounds the Seventh Trumpet-**

*“The seventh angel sounded his trumpet, and there were loud voices in heaven, which said: “The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of his Christ, and he will reign forever and ever.”*
